HOLY ROSARY CHURCH ROOF REPAIRS: Our Parish Pastoral Council met this week to consider whether to replace the left slope of the church roof and to consider a proposal from Gillis Home Building Center. Considering the seriousness of the situation with the roof, it was decided to accept the Gillis proposal of \$21,000. It should be noted, that considering our tentative situation and the longevity of the parish, we must consider that we ended the past two years with a deficit, and it is because of our savings that we can face this major expense. In addition to the roof expense, we have had to deal with a \$3,000 bill for repairs to the furnace and another \$1,000 for a new keyboard for the piano. We are trusting on the generosity of parishioners.
