

TRANSUBSTANTIATION: We explain the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist by "transubstantiation" which means that the substance of the consecrated bread and wine is changed to the substance of the risen Jesus' glorified Body and Blood by the action of the Holy Spirit and its accidents (like color, shape, taste, etc) remain the same..
