FEAST OF ST. BAKHITA: Bakhita was born in Sudan in 1869. She was sold as a slave beginning at the age of nine until 1883 when she was sold to the Italian Consul family who treated her with kindness and warmth. When they returned to Italy, they took Bakhita with them. She lived with the Canossian Sisters in Venice. She was baptized and became a member of the community which she served for 50 years. She lived a simple life as a cook, seamstress and doorkeeper. She was known as "Our Black Mother". She died in 1947 and was Canonized in 2000. (Fr. Murphy attended the Canonization). Her Feast Day coincides with the Church's International Day of Prayer and Awareness Against Human Trafficking.
